

Autumn Term 1 Journey Through Space

Core Value: Creativity and Resilience

Rationale: (why are we doing it?)

This memorable experience will allow the children the opportunity to celebrate the forthcoming 50^{th} anniversary of the first moon landing. We will be taking the children on a 'Journey Through Space' to discover the importance of space exploration and learn about the different planets. The children will get to explore a variety of space stories to stimulate their imagination for their own writing of space stories. They will also be given the opportunity to investigate and use a variety of other exciting medium in space related activities.

The Hook:

A NASA stimulated rocket launch where the children will role play being an astronaut.

Authentic Outcome:

A virtual reality journey through space.

The main curriculum subjects which focus on the outcome

English -

Recount of the first moon landing.

Non-fiction information sheet on the planets.

Retelling a space adventure story.

Writing of their own space adventure story.

Art and D & T

To create their own NASA space picture using the process of felting.

History

We will be looking at the life of Neil Armstrong as a significant individual and paying particular attention to the importance the first moon landing and the impact it has had on national life.

The other areas of the curriculum.

Reading Focus -

Using phonics to sound out new words, Discuss stories read.

Spelling & Grammar Focus -

Segmenting and blending for spelling. Letter recognition, correct letter formation, capital letter, full stop, question mark. Spelling Zappers
